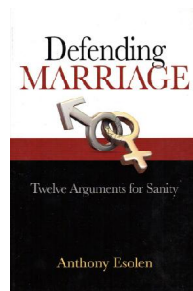

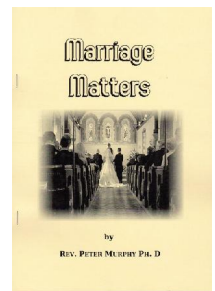
Defending Marriage: Twelve Arguments for Sanity by Anthony Esolen \$24.95 (special)

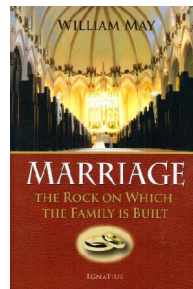
Marriage Matters by Rev. Dr Peter Murphy \$9.95

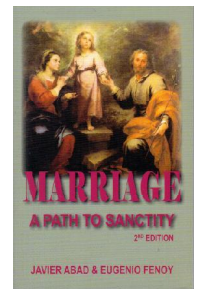
Marriage the Rock on which the Family is Built \$26.00 (special)

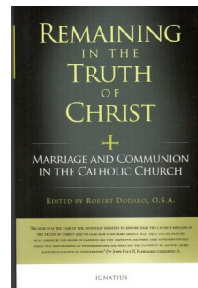
Marriage a Path to Sanctity by Javier Abad and Eugenio Fenoy \$19.95

Many couples have attested that reading this book has saved and strengthened their marriages. The authors explain that Marriage is a path to sanctity through self-sacrificing love.



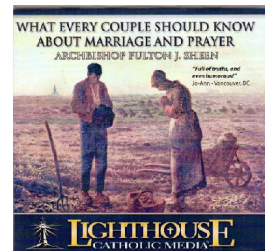
Remaining in the Truth of Christ Robert Dodaro (ed) \$39.95 (special)

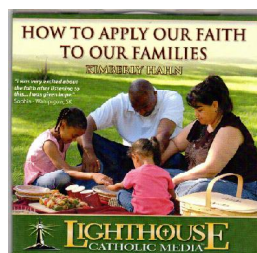

Through anecdotes and true stories Fulton Sheen leaves us in no doubt that prayer is the most important element of married life.



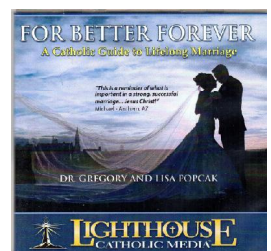

Kimberley Hahn gives a deep and meaningful reminder to parents about our duties to raise and educate our children in the Catholic Faith.



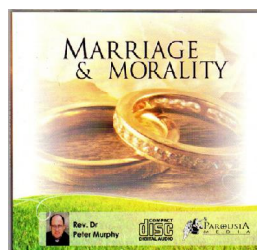

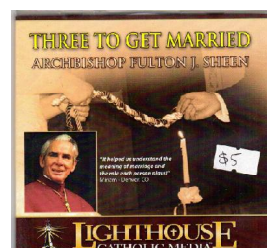
Marriage and Morality by Rev Dr Peter Murphy CD \$5.00

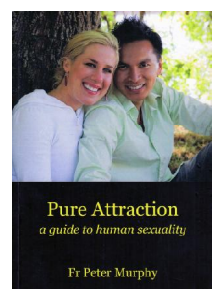
Statue The Holy Family \$89.00

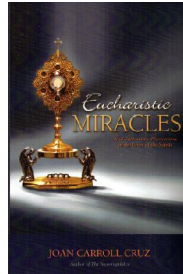


April —The Month of the Holy Eucharist

We should strive to be worthy of all those amazing graces. Easter usually occurs during this month of April which is dedicated to the Holy Eucharist. How wonderful is it that the Last Supper fell within the first week of April this year. There are many great saints some of whom had a deep devotion to Jesus in the Holy Eucharist celebrating feasts this month including St Gemma Galgani on 1st, St Bernadette 16th, St Peter Chanel and St Louis Marie de Montfort 28th, St Catherine of Siena 29th and St Pius V 30th. On 25th April we remember our fallen soldiers who fought at Anzac Cove but we must never cease to pray for the souls of all the soldiers who fought in the Great War, all of whom are now dead.

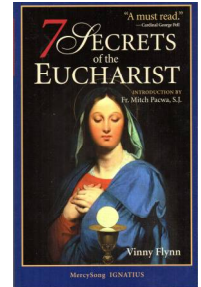
Eucharistic Miracles by Joan Carroll Cruz \$24.75

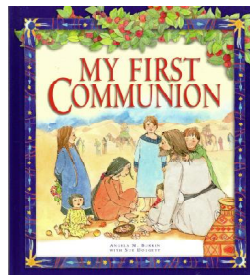
7 Secrets of the Eucharist by Vinny Flynn \$15.95

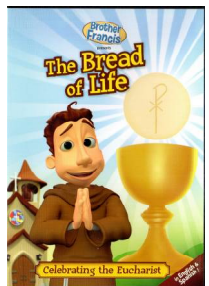
My First Communion by Angela M Burrin \$12.95

This beautifully illustrated book helps children understand the tremendous love Jesus has for each of us as he comes to us in the Holy Eucharist.



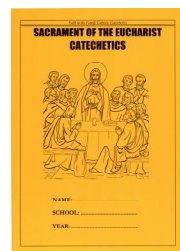
Brother Francis 2: The Bread of Life - DVD \$14.45

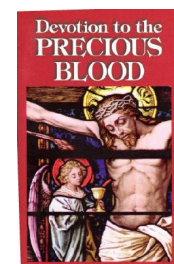
Brother Francis Colouring and Activity Book 2: The Bread of Life \$4.25

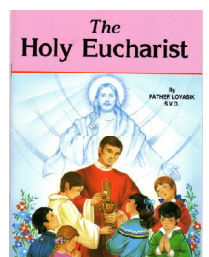
Devotion to the Precious Blood Anonymous \$4.50

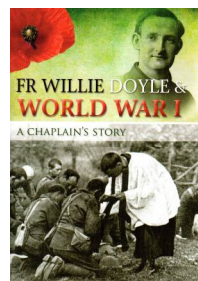
The Holy Eucharist by Father Lovasik \$2.80

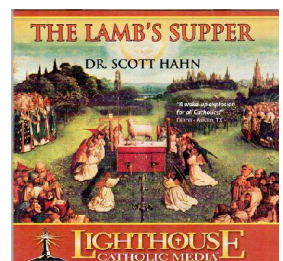
Fr Willie Doyle and World War I by K V Turley \$7.00

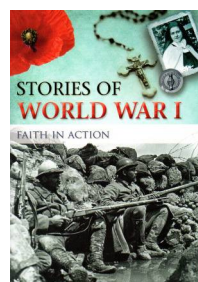
The Lamb's Supper by Scott Hahn CD \$5.00

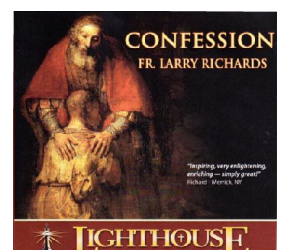
Stories of World War I ed. Raymond Edwards, compiled by Sr Fabiola \$7.00

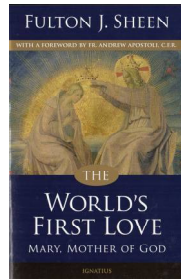


May—the Month of Mary

Mary is the Queen of Saints, the one chosen by God to be the Mother of Jesus because she was always "Full of Grace" from the moment of her conception. Her humility, her virtue, her co-operation with the will of God are unequalled. She loves us deeply and will beg God for anything we need. Christ showed us through his love, honour and obedience towards her how wonderful Mary really is. As He was dying on the Cross He gave her to us so that she could be our mother also. The beautiful feast of Our Lady Help of Christians, Patron of Australia, is celebrated on 25th as the great feast of Pentecost Sunday, the day when the Paraclete descended on the Apostles and Mary in the form of tongues of fire, falls on 24th this year. Our Lady first appeared to the children of Fatima on May 13th 1917 and the feast of the Visitation occurs on May 31st. Many wonderful saints are honoured this month with feast days beginning on May 1st with St Joseph the Worker, patron of the Universal Church, St Athanasius 2nd, the Apostles Philip and James the Lesser 3rd, St Damien of Molokai 11th, St Rita of Cascia 22nd and St Philip Neri 26th.

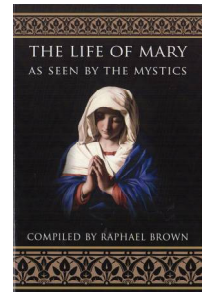
The World's First Love by Fulton Sheen \$21.95 (Special)

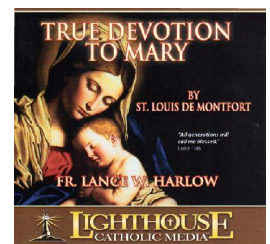
The Glories of Mary by St Alphonsus Ligouri \$33.00

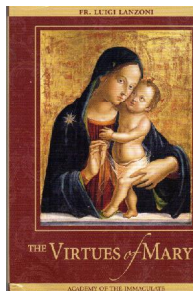
True Devotion to Mary by St Louis De Montfort reviewed by Fr Lance W Harlow CD \$5.00

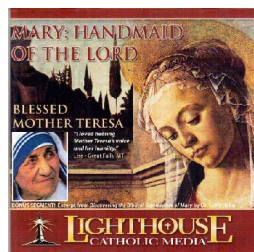
Statue - Our Lady of Grace 150mm \$25.00

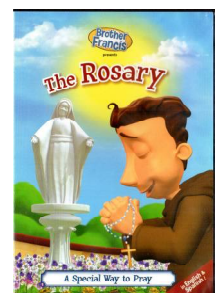
Mary: Handmaid of the Lord by Blessed Mother Teresa CD \$5.00

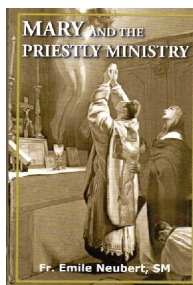
Brother Francis 3 : The Rosary - DVD \$14.45

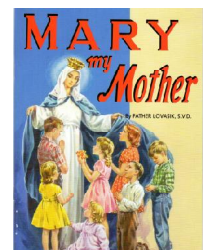
Mary and the Priestly Ministry by Father Emile Neubert SM \$12.80

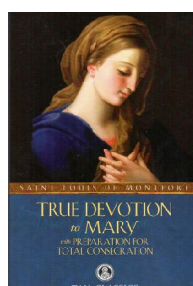
Mary My Mother by Father Lovasik \$2.80

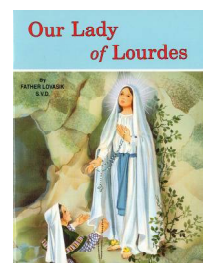
True Devotion to Mary By St Louis-Marie Grignion De Montfort \$19.50 (Special)

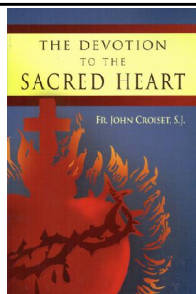


June—The Month of the Sacred Heart

Our Lord loves us so deeply, so much that words can never describe this incredible love. He appeared to St Margaret Mary so that people would truly understand just a small portion of it. The importance of the devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus is so great that He asked that a feast be instituted in honour of His Sacred Heart. Though Christ gives us free will this feast is a reminder of His tremendous love for us and the incredible suffering He goes through when we reject Him by sinning. There are beautiful rewards, that Christ has promised those people who devote themselves to Him. The great feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus occurs on the Friday before the third Sunday after Pentecost or the Sunday after the wonderful feast of Corpus Christi. This year The Sacred Heart of Jesus is on 12th June, with the following day being the feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary. The feast of St Anthony of Padua is also celebrated on 13th. Other feast days that occur in June are St Margaret of Scotland 10th, St Thomas More 22nd, the birth of St John the Baptist 24th, St Irenaeus 28th and the great Apostles Sts Peter and Paul 29th.

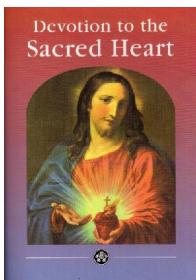
The Devotion to the Sacred Heart by Fr John Croiset \$24.75 (on special until 30th June)

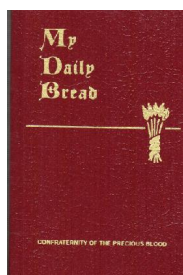
Devotion to the Sacred Heart by Catholic Truth Society \$5.00

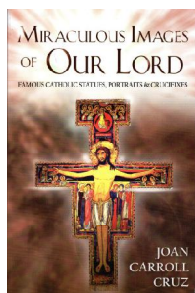
My Daily Bread by Father Anthony J Paone \$17.60

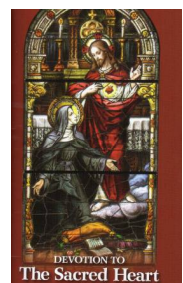
Miraculous Images of Our Lord by Joan Carroll Cruz \$20.90

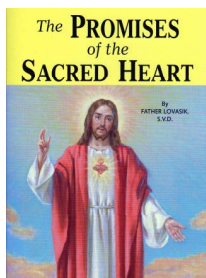
Devotion to the Sacred Heart By servant of God Fr Lukas Etlin \$5.00

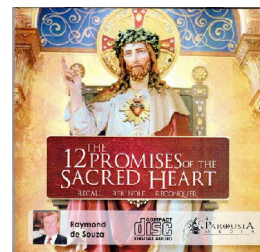
The Promises of the Sacred Heart by Father Lovasik \$2.80

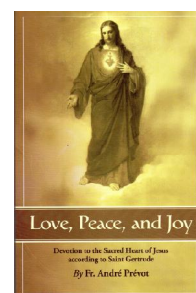
The 12 Promises of the Sacred Heart by Raymond de Souza CD \$5.00

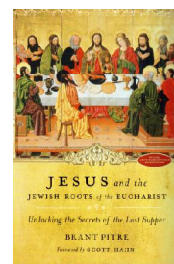
Love, Peace, and Joy by Fr Andre Prevot \$15.90

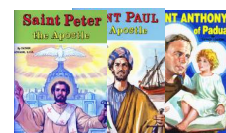
Saint Anthony The Wonder-Worker of Padua by Charles Warren Stoddard \$14.50

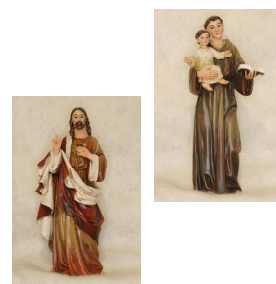
St Peter by Fr Lovasik, St Paul by Fr Lovasik and St Anthony of Padua by Fr Lovasik \$2.80 each

Bush Boys

The Bush Boys series of books by Fr James Tierney is the best Australian series ever written for children. The author has a keen wit, deep insights about what interests children, a fabulous appreciation of the Australian bush, a thorough knowledge of the art of camping and an engaging style of writing.

There are five books and now the first two are published in a single volume. They are packed full of mystery and adventure as the Cumberland boys and later the Lawson boys set off seeking excitement exploring rugged Australian ridges, thick scrub, wide, fast-flowing creeks, sparkling waterfalls and towering trees on their overnight camping trips. They learn to swim, build a fire without newspaper, pitch a tent in bad weather, survive a snake attack and outwit shady characters.

They encounter rival gangs, crack secret codes, become embroiled in mischief and engage in pillow fighting and mud fights and then deal with the consequences. Interaction with their parents, sisters and cousins is sometimes quite humorous and other times deadly serious.

Today we are bombarded by a media that openly tolerates and supports actions that are contrary to the way we are made and the laws of nature. They want to make us believe that materialism and satisfaction of our every desire, whether good or bad, is best for us. They want us to believe that goodness and chivalry are dead and ultimately their aim is to destroy the family.

Bush Boys is refreshing because it demonstrates that the opposite is true. It is about the ordinary lives of ordinary people who live close to nature. It shows how normal it is to be close to God, your family and your surroundings and how much happiness this harmony brings.
