MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

Friends and supporters of CNFRI are reminded about the celebration of Holy Mass in praise and thanksgiving for the Priesthood of our founder and Priest Director, Father James Tierney, to be held on Saturday 26th September 2015, at 9:30am, at the Shrine of Our Lady of Mercy, Penrose Park. The Mass will be celebrated by Father Tierney in honour of his Golden Jubilee of ordination and his 80th birthday.

Following the Mass, there will be refreshments in the marquee. Please bring a plate to share and deliver it to the marquee prior to the commencement of mass. Tea, coffee and hot water will be available. The Shrine is located at 120 Hanging Rock Rd Sutton Forest. Heading south on the Hume Highway, turn right into Hanging Rock Rd 2km after the McDonalds/Shell service centre. The Shrine entrance is located 1 km along Hanging Rock Rd on the right hand side.

In other news, we are delighted that Fr Brendan Murphy SDB, Parish Priest Our Lady of the Rosary Parish St Marys, has now named the old infants school site at St Marys the "Saint Mary of the Cross Mackillop Centre", commonly known as the Mackillop Centre. We operate our apostolic work from two classrooms on this site, and work closely with the parish. The new statues, garden and Shrine to St Mary Mackillop are a credit to Fr Murphy and his parish, and certainly complement the apostolic work of CNFRI.

Roses Among Thorns by St Francis de Sales 19.95



Brown Scapulars from \$1.60 -\$4.00



Devotion to the Precious Blood from Tan Books \$4.50





August —The Month of the Immaculate Heart of Mary




The Second Greatest Story Ever Told by Michael E Gaitley MIC \$25.95 Special Price \$22.50 (July-Sept)

In 1802 during the excavations of the Catacomb of St Priscilla, the remains of a small unknown twelve year old girl and a vial of her dried blood were found. Her relics were given to a Neopolitan priest, Don Francesco de Lucia, who had requested them in 1805 to be enshrined in the village church at Mugnano. Since then numerous favours, graces and miracles have been attributed to the little girl, known as St Philomena. Pope Gregory XVI elevated her to sainthood in 1837.







The Life of the Blessed Virgin Mary from the Visions of Ven. Anne Catherine Emmerich \$27.50




Novena to the Immaculate Heart of Mary from Cromo Italy \$4.50

September --- The Month of Our Lady of Sorrows

The Seven Sorrows of Our Lady are as follows: the Prophecy of Simeon during the Presentation in the Temple (the Circumcision of Christ), the Flight into Egypt, Losing the Child Jesus in the Temple, Mary meeting Jesus on the way to Calvary, Jesus death on the cross, the piercing of the side of Jesus (and the body of Jesus being placed in her arms) and the body of Jesus being placed in the tomb. Meditating on these sorrows helps us realise that many of our trials and sufferings are small compared to hers and yet if we pray to her she is always ready to help. There are many graces and promises attached to the devotion of the Seven Sorrows. Feasts in this month include St Gregory on 3rd, the Birth of the Blessed Virgin on 8th, Exultation of the Holy Cross on 14th, Our Lady of Sorrows on 15th, St Pio on 23rd and St Michael, St Gabriel and St Raphael on 29th



This is the most thorough book about angels, despite being written in the 20th century. It deals with the choirs of Angels, St Michael and the fall, St Raphael and St Gabriel. It also deals with many dubious practices such as Astrology, Satanism, Witchcraft, and Tarot Cards among others as well as Lucifer.


Devotion to the Sorrowful Mother from Tan Books \$5.00


Send Me Your Guardian Angel (Padre Pio) by Fr Alessio Parente \$29.95

A Prayer Book of Favourite Litanies compiled by Fr Albert J Hebert SM






What's New? Survivals and Old Revivals!
